A native of Spain, Cristina Bertrand earned her Ph.D. in Philosophy and Letters at the Complutense University of Madrid. Her doctoral dissertation about the Chinese book of wisdom, Yi Jing, was an interdisciplinary research in the fields of philosophy, geography, history and art of China. Dr. Bertrand is an internationally recognized scholar and artist and has completed more than 550 paintings exhibited in galleries in Spain, the United States, Europe and China.

After leaving Spain, Dr. Bertrand spent 20 years in the United States, living in Los Angeles, New York and Miami Beach, and 7 years in Shanghai. Presently, she lives in Shanghai, Hong Kong, and Miami Beach, where she lectures on the Yi Jing and presides over her Chinese company Cristina Bertrand (Shanghai) Trading Co., Ltd., and Hong Kong company Cristina Bertrand Limited, which market her artwork, books, perfumes, jewels, and fashion. The Kèyí School offers conferences, seminars and workshops in Chinese culture, Yi Jing, Yi Jing applied to Business, and Chinese Language based on her innovative teaching methodology Kèyí.
